Our Mission:

To provide individualized work experiences within a supportive rehabilitation environment to facilitate and strengthen vocational skills and employability, returning Veterans to living and working in the community.

Nationally VHA's CWT program staff provide vocational rehabilitation services to over 40,000 OEF/OIF, Desert Storm, and Vietnam Veterans.

These are Veterans who served their country, have severe mental or physical challenges and service or non-service connected ratings.

During fiscal year 2007, over one-third of Veterans leaving the CWT program were competitively employed.

The CWT Transitional Work and Supported Employment Program

CWT/Transitional Work Experience (CWT/TWE) is a pre-employment vocational assessment program for Veterans that operates in VA medical centers and communities across our nation. CWT/TWE participants are assessed by vocational professionals, pre-screened and matched to the specific job requirement. Typically the CWT/TWE assignment lasts for three to six months as negotiated between program staff and the participating company. CWT/TWE functions like a temp-to-hire labor service so the expectations of veteran workers is the same as that of other non-CWT workers in the company. Normal employee benefit costs such as FICA, vacation or sick time, or workers compensation insurance are not charged to participating companies.

CWT/Supported Employment (CWT/SE) functions like a free employee assistance program for competitive employment with time unlimited supports. CWT/SE staff pre-screen applicants to available competitive job opportunities and refer qualified Veterans for consideration. Employers who hire CWT referred Veterans will have access to post-employment follow-along services, employer education, worksite analysis and Tax Credits for Targeted Jobs.

What is the CWT Service Area?

There are 169 CWT programs operating at most VA Medical Centers. Collectively, these programs served over 40,000 new Veterans each year. See reverse for a map illustrating CWT program locations.

How Does CWT Affect Your Company's Bottom Line?

The CWT/TWE program allows you an opportunity to evaluate a potential employee and provides a low cost means to assess worker skills prior to making an employment decision. CWT/SE eliminates the need for your company to advertise and recruit employees. CWT/SE staff form a long term relationship with the employer becoming familiar with individual job needs to facilitate referral of qualified workers and to improve your company's applicant pool.

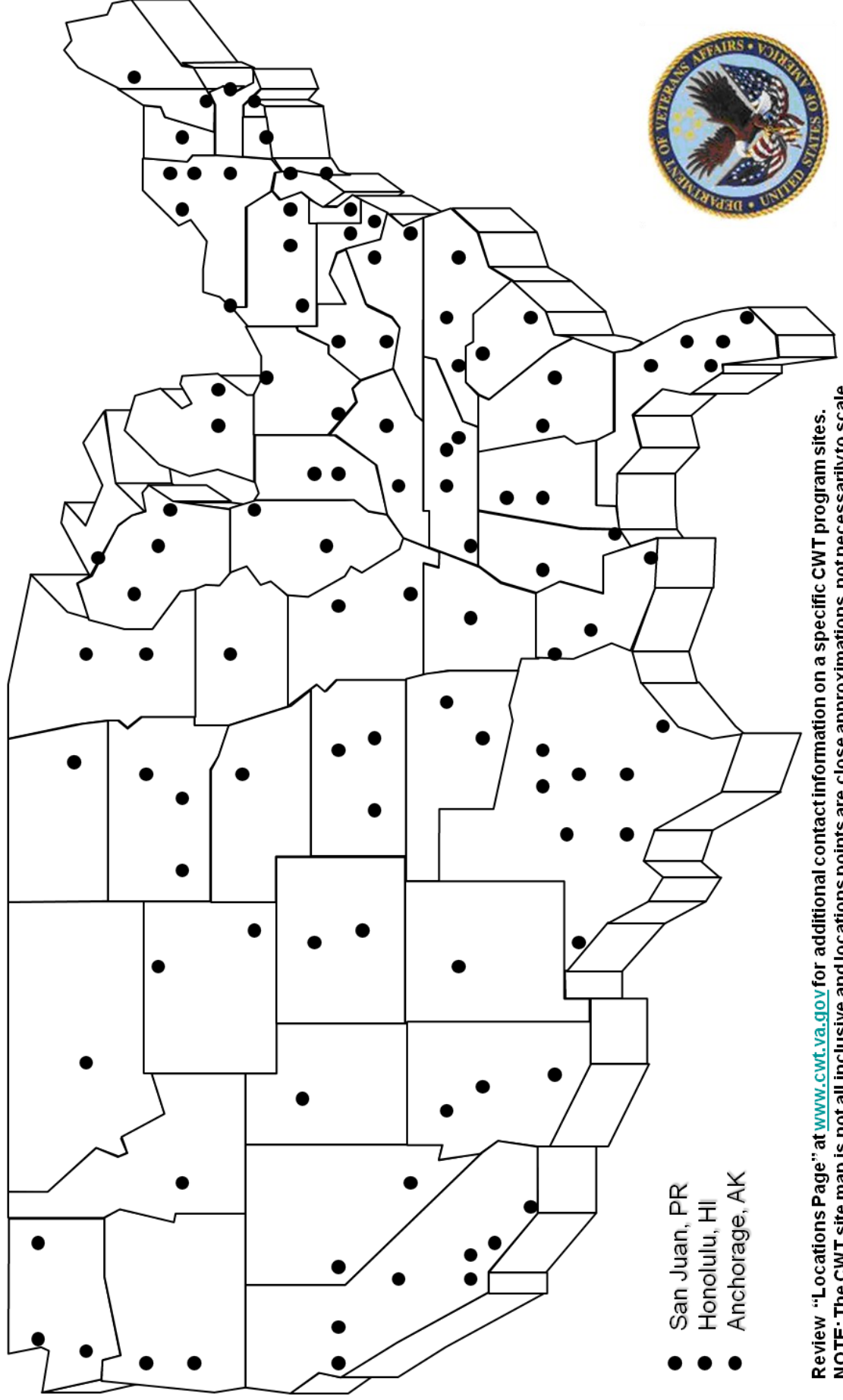
